Eligibility Requirements

Multi-Country Partnership

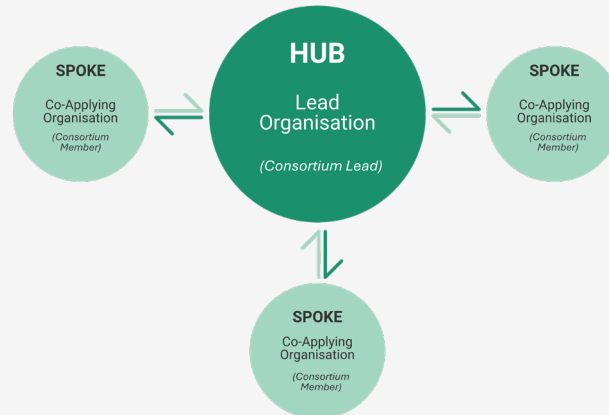
Each consortium must include **at least three organisations**, each from a different Southeast Asian country. The Consortium Lead must be a legal entity registered in one of these 11 Southeast Asian countries:



Consortium Composition

A consortium should consist of **three to five organisations**, including the Lead Organisation who will administer the organisation.

More than five may participate if clearly beneficial to the consortium.



Consortia are designed in a **hub-and-spoke structure**, with the Lead serving as the central hub that coordinates, manages funds, and supports the Member Organisations as spokes.

Inclusive Representation

Each consortium must include **at least one organisation** from a **Lower Middle-Income Country (LMIC)*** in Southeast Asia.

Regional and Global Collaboration

Organisations from countries outside of Southeast Asia can be Consortium Members and receive funds, but are not eligible to be the Lead Organisation.
